

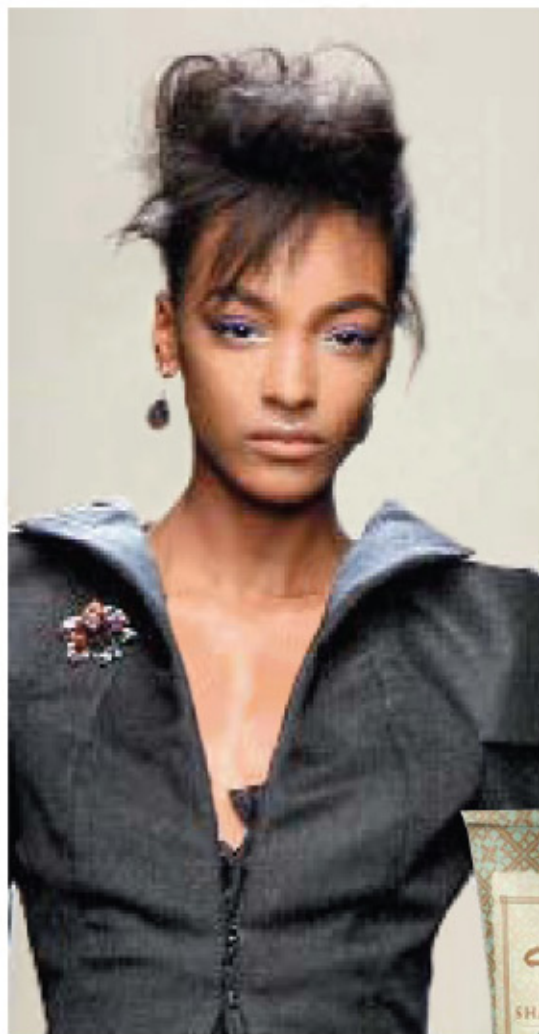

TRENDY TRESSES FOR FALL

Sartorial statements aside, the runways for fall were packed with covetable coifs: Think smooth blowouts, romantic curls and glam-punk updos. But how to translate these high-design dos into something attainable? We asked four local stylists to re-create the season's freshest looks.

» Downtown Updo at Bottega Veneta

Theresa Mosely, Bubbles (1961 Chain Bridge Rd., McLean, 703-448-3987, www.bubblesalon.com)

1. To prep damp hair, Mosely suggests blending a small amount of **Cibu's Shang High thickening paste** (\$18) with the line's **Oso Shimmer smoothing solution** (\$18) and applying from roots to ends. Then blow-dry, using a round or paddle brush until your hair is smooth and dry.
2. Use a 1½-inch-diameter curling iron to create loose curls all over your head, which will make it easier to mold the hair. Starting at the nape, curl 1½-inch sections loosely, working up and along the sides to the top of the head. After the hair is curled, apply a working hair spray. "You don't want a spray that's too stiff, because this look has a lot of softness," Mosely says.
3. Using a small, flat brush, start at the nape and brush hair straight up, then secure with bobby pins at the crown. To get model Jourdan Dunn's rocker-chic look, allow loose ends to stick up at the crown. For hair that's too short to reach the crown area, use your fingers or a flat iron to shape them into wisps above the ears.
4. Take the section of hair at the front hairline and use a fine-toothed comb to gently back-comb. Smooth the hair around three or four fingers and push the section forward to get a slight bouffant. Tuck the ends under and secure with pins. To finish this look, use your fingers and a working spray to give loose ends at the crown a spiky, piecey look. For bangs, use a flat iron to curl them slightly under. Then mist with a light shine-boosting hair spray, such as **Cibu's Sashini** (\$18).
